

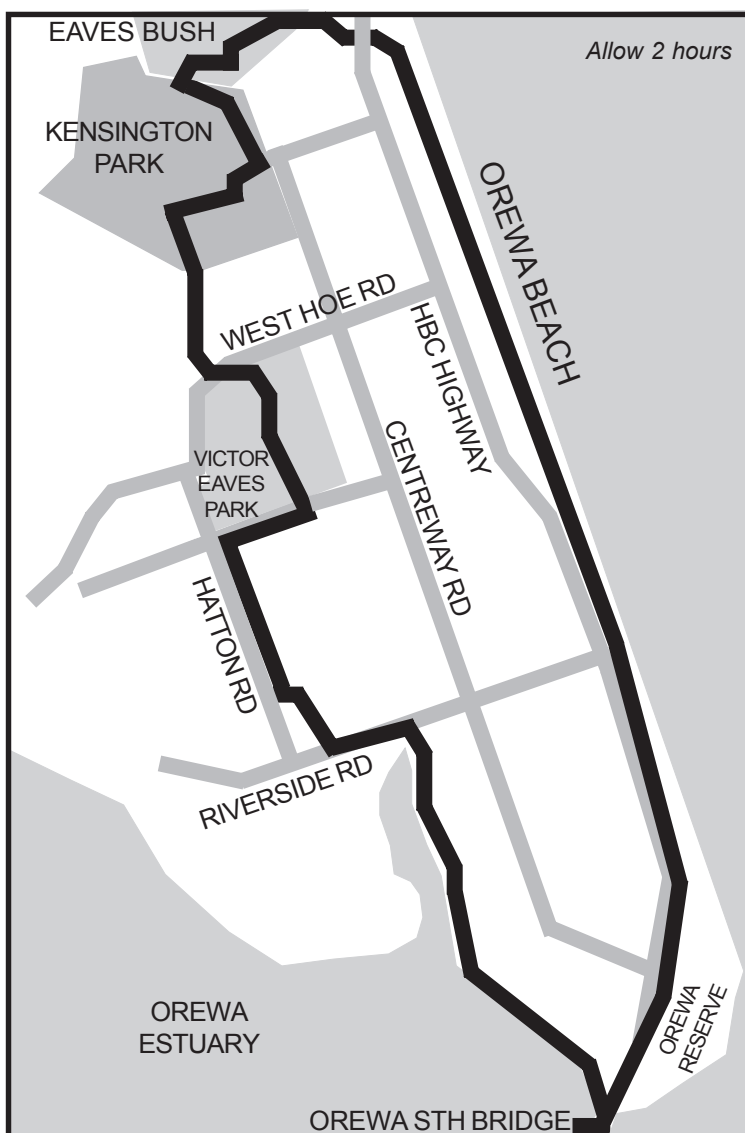
PUBLIC NOTICE

In Association with the Eaves Bush Appreciation Group and Rodney District Council, Kensington Park is pleased to announce the

Orewa Millennium Walkway

has now re-opened through Kensington Park.

In addition, these groups have just completed extensive track improvements within the Alice Eaves native bush reserve to help protect the 800 year old hollow Kauri tree.



**The Orewa Millennium Walkway route.
Follow the BLUE footprints.**

- Start from the Orewa south bridge, follow the estuary to Centreway Reserve. You will pass the Centrestage Theatre and the Rodney District Council.
- Turn left down Riverside Rd and cross the road into Grant Park.
- Go right along Hatton Rd, right into Florence Ave, then go left to enter Victor Eaves Park. Cross West Hoe rd, right into West Hoe Heights, then right into Millennial Way to enter Kensington Park. Go right down Puriri Boulevard, left into Parkside Dr, then right onto Kensington Drive.
- At the end of Kensington Dr, the temporary walkway links to Eaves Bush, over the foot-bridge that crosses the Nukumea stream.
- Walk through Eaves Bush to the Old North Rd end, go right to travel over the Orewa north traffic bridge. Go under the bridge to the right, to join the Orewa beach.
- Go along the Orewa beachfront, returning to the south bridge. Go over the bridge, cross under the bridge, back over, to return to where you started.

NOTE: Some tracks through Kensington Park are at present temporary, and will be upgraded upon completion of the affected stage of development.
